- The Tri-M Music Honor Society® is the national program of NAfME which focuses on creating future leaders in music education and music advocacy
- 2020 marked 84 years of the Tri-M program











Who is involved?



- 1,775 chapters across 50 states and 15 countries
- 75,000 students in grades 6-12
- Tri-M students contribute more than 750,000 service hours to their school and local communities annually
- Each year, Tri-M students raise nearly \$1 million for causes they care about

- Increases musical independence and discovery for its members
- Advocates for the importance and value of music education in shaping the leaders of tomorrow
- Highlights the school's music program and establishes credibility within the surrounding community

Membership Criteria

Music Participation

Candidates must have been enrolled in a school-sponsored music ensemble and/or class for at least one semester of the current school year.

Academic Achievement

Candidates must have maintained for the previous semester at least an A average grade or equivalent in music, with at least a cumulative B average grade or equivalent in other academic subjects.

Leadership

School or community activities that students are involved in will also be considered.

Service

Service activities include any actions undertaken by the student that are done with or on behalf of others without any direct financial or material compensation to the individual performing the service.

Character

Judgment of character should be free of speculation and rumor. One description of character is a person who demonstrates respect, responsibility, trustworthiness, fairness, caring, and citizenship.


