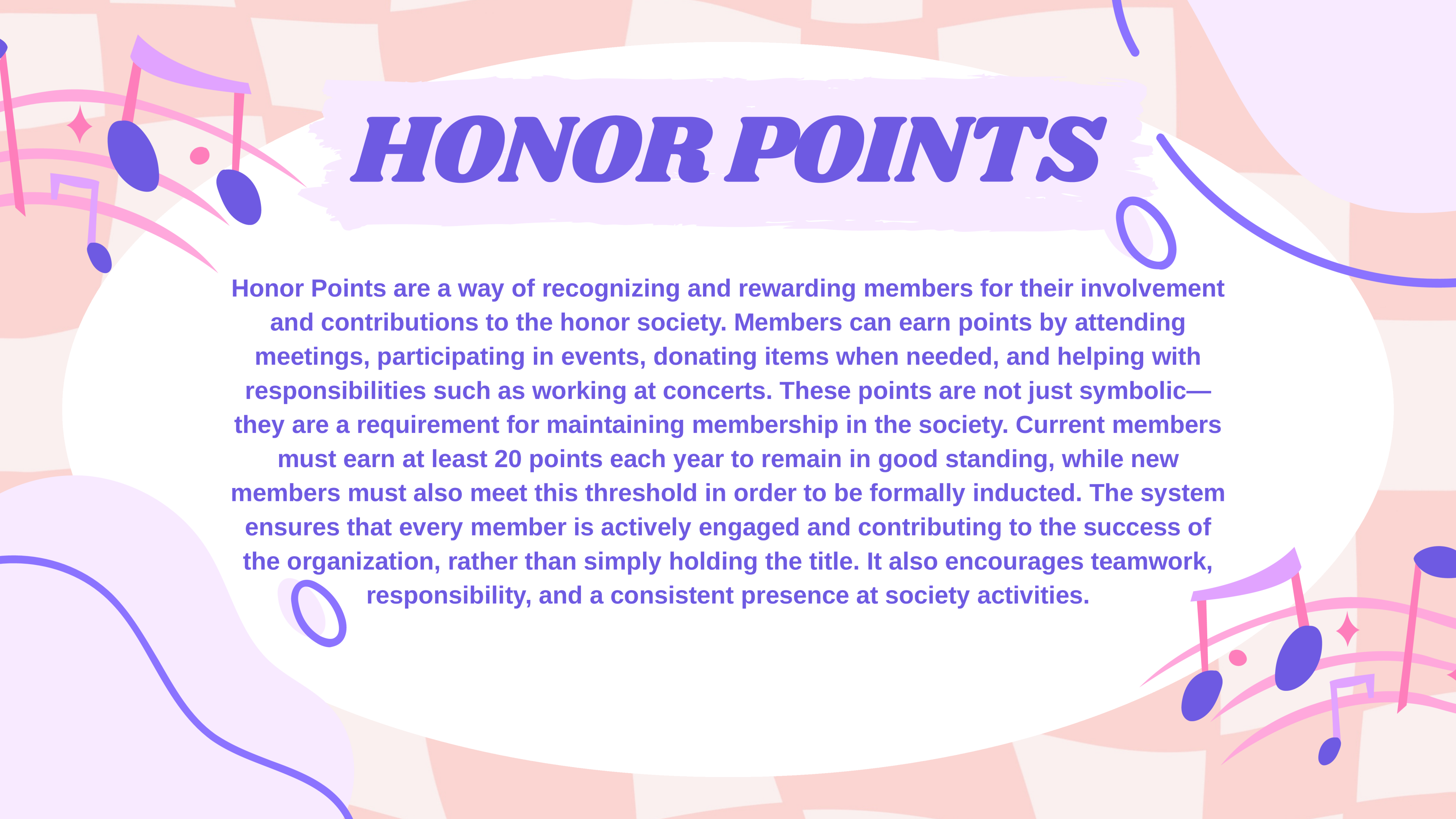
Meeting Overview

HONOR POINTS

Honor Points are a way of recognizing and rewarding members for their involvement and contributions to the honor society. Members can earn points by attending meetings, participating in events, donating items when needed, and helping with responsibilities such as working at concerts. These points are not just symbolic—they are a requirement for maintaining membership in the society. Current members must earn at least 20 points each year to remain in good standing, while new members must also meet this threshold in order to be formally inducted. The system ensures that every member is actively engaged and contributing to the success of the organization, rather than simply holding the title. It also encourages teamwork, responsibility, and a consistent presence at society activities.

Important

Attendance is extremely important! Please make every effort to attend all meetings, as we will be covering important information, updates, and reminders that affect everyone in Tri-M.

In the Tri-M bylaws, it clearly states that members may not miss more than three meetings per year. If a member exceeds this limit, their membership will be revoked for the rest of the year, and they would need to reapply the following year in order to rejoin.

Please also remember that leaving a meeting early counts as an absence. Staying for the full duration not only ensures you meet the requirements but also shows your dedication to the organization and helps you stay informed about upcoming events and opportunities.
